Your physician has recommended that you undergo:

Please follow these instructions to prepare for your procedure

1. Nothing to eat or drink 6-8 hours prior to the procedure.
2. Necessary medications ONLY, 2 hours prior to the procedure.
3. DO NOT TAKE ANY pain medications, sedatives, tranquilizers or antispasmodics the day of the procedure, until after the procedure is completed.

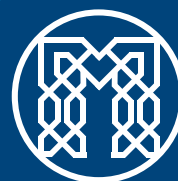
___ Bravo Capsule Placement (Ambulatory pH Study): scheduled on _____

Please follow these instructions to prepare for your procedure

1. Nothing to eat or drink after midnight the night prior to the procedure.
2. STOP all Proton Pump Inhibitors, such as: Prilosec (omeprazole), Protonix (Pantoprazole), Nexium (Esomeprazole), Dexilant (Dexlansoprazole), Prevacid (Lansoprazole), Aciphex (Rabeprazole), Pepcid, Zantac, or Tagamet, 5 days prior to your scheduled procedure. You may supplement being off your medication for acid reflux with over the counter Maalox or Mylanta as directed on the bottle. You may take this until the day before your scheduled procedure. Maalox/Mylanta must be stopped 12 hours prior to the procedure.
