The JRCERT has defined “not actively seeking employment” as:

- 1) Graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts OR
- 2) Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation OR
- 3) Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours OR
- 4) Graduate is on active military duty OR
- 5) Graduate is continuing education.

Calculations for 5 year averaging

5 year credentialing exam pass rate 1st attempt	47/56=83.9%	(# 1st time pass / # 1st time examines)
5 year program completion rate	56/72=77.8%	(# graduates / # students starting program)
5 year program attrition rate.	16/72= 22.2%	(# students not completing program / # students starting program)
5 year job placement rate	48 / 48 = 100%	(# graduates with verified employment / # graduates seeking employment)
